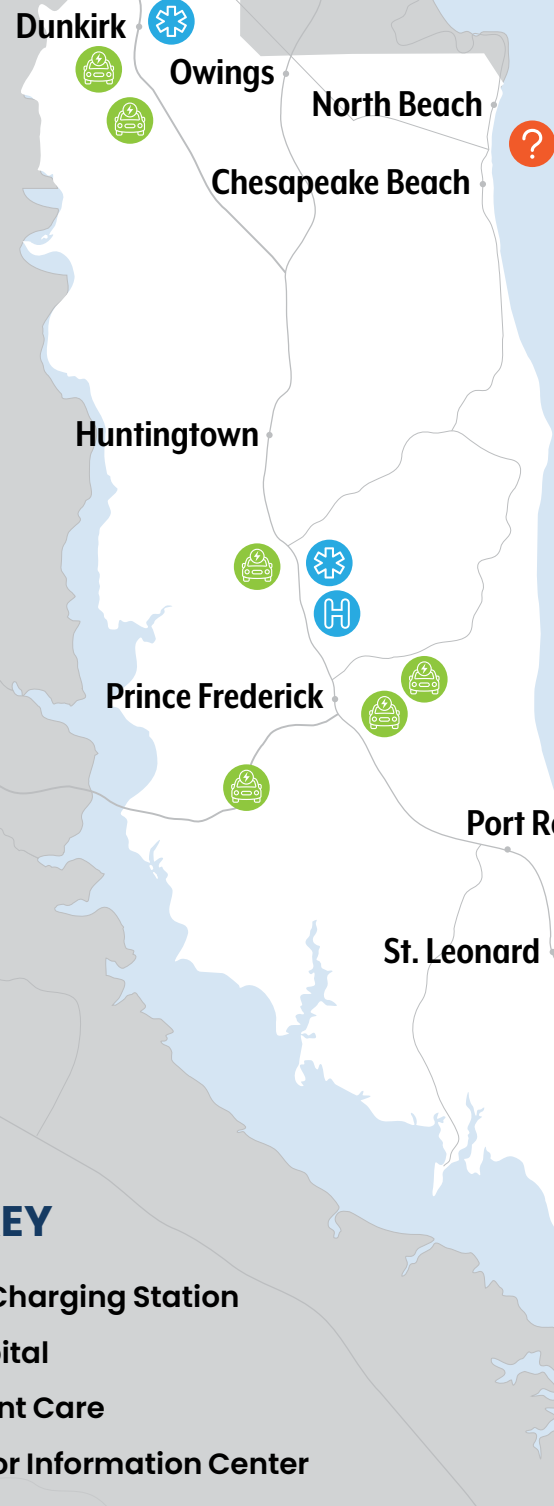

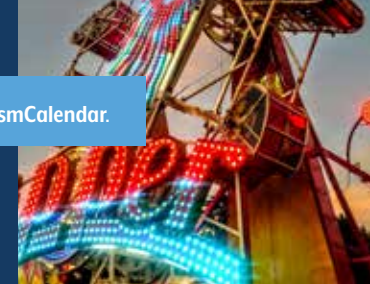

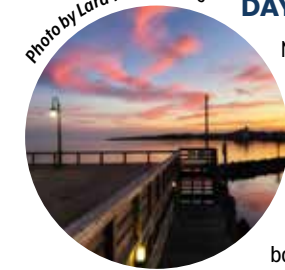

# 72 HOURS IN Calvert County

There is so much to see and do in Calvert County, it can be hard knowing where to start. Here are some ideas to inspire you and help make the most of your time here. But don't feel limited to just 72 hours; we'd love for you to stay longer.

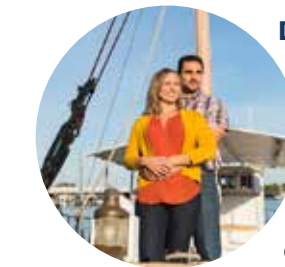

## DAY 1: NORTH COUNTY

Nestled on the Chesapeake Bay's western shore, the neighboring towns of North Beach and Chesapeake Beach epitomize the "land of pleasant living." Start at the seven-block waterfront in North Beach offering a public fishing pier, boardwalk and bike path. At the Bayside History Museum, learn about the bayside communities through vintage signs, restaurant menus and objects found along the shoreline. Take a leisurely stroll down the boardwalk, browse gift shops, art galleries and antiques. Stop for lunch at a locally owned restaurant, scope out some wildlife at Wetlands Overlook Park and the sculpture-filled Mark P. Frazer Sunrise Garden and finish up with some sweet treats.

Next, head to Chesapeake Beach where you can step back in time at the Chesapeake Beach Railway Museum to learn about the railroad and amusement park history of this town. Continue the fun with the kids at the Chesapeake Beach Water Park, then head out on a charter boat from the "Charter Boat Capital of Maryland" to catch some big ones on the bay. For dinner, crack a few crabs at one of several restaurant options and catch a waterside concert at the Rod 'N' Reel bandstand. Contemplate the magnificent Chesapeake Bay from Memorial Park while the sun sets on your perfect day.



## DAY 2: SOUTH COUNTY

Where the Patuxent River meets the Chesapeake Bay, you will find Solomons Island, a place of uncommon charm and unspoiled beauty. Visit the Calvert Marine Museum or the Chesapeake Biological Lab Visitor Center to trace the rich maritime history and diversity of the Chesapeake Bay. Climb through the hatch at Drum Point Lighthouse or check out Cove Point Lighthouse, the oldest continuously working lighthouse on the Chesapeake Bay. A short cruise on the museum's historic *Wm. B. Tennison* bugeye boat or traditional skipjack, *The Dee*, gives an unforgettable view of the soaring Thomas Johnson Bridge. Next, head to Annmarie Sculpture Garden & Arts Center featuring art inside and out. Many sculptures lining the wooded path are on loan from the Smithsonian Institution. At the arts center, view changing exhibits or be creative in the artLAB. Finish your day at a waterside restaurant. From steaks to seafood, there's something for everyone in this quaint community.



## DAY 3: OUTDOOR FUN



The towering cliffs of the Chesapeake Bay at Calvert Cliffs State Park are etched with imprints of creatures from many eons ago when this area was covered by an ancient sea. Find prehistoric shark teeth on the beach and relax as your children play on the recycled tire playground. Head over to Jefferson Patterson Park & Museum situated on 560 acres along the Patuxent River and St. Leonard Creek. Explore the visitor and exhibit center, children's discovery room and re-created eastern woodland Native American village. Learn about archaeology through a "behind-the-scenes" tour of the Maryland Archaeological Conservation Laboratory. Continue on to Battle Creek Cypress Swamp Sanctuary where a boardwalk trail winds through one of the northernmost stands of bald cypress trees in North America. Learn more in the nature center and see some wildlife up close. Finish your day with a locally made wine or freshly brewed beer from one of Calvert County's local wineries or breweries.

## Annmarie Sculpture Garden & Arts Center Solomons • 410-326-4640

A must-see in Solomons, Annmarie Garden features a beautiful sculpture path that meanders through the woods past works on loan from the Smithsonian Institution along with other artful surprises, a children's natural play space and native gardens. The gallery hosts exhibits, a unique gift shop, the Nature Nook and the artLAB, where guests create their own works of art. All ages will enjoy events and festivals, hands-on activities and public art programs in this gorgeous park. Leashed pets welcomed except at special events.

## Jefferson Patterson Park & Museum St. Leonard • 410-586-8538

Jefferson Patterson Park & Museum is full of secrets waiting to be unearthed. Whether you come to hike the miles of trails, explore the Visitor Center full of interactive exhibits, tour the Maryland Archaeological Conservation Laboratory with more than 8 million historic and prehistoric artifacts, or enjoy an educational program or event, you will leave with a greater appreciation for the land and the people who once lived here.



## Calvert Marine Museum Solomons • 410-326-2042

Rich maritime history, local fossils and aquariums relating to life in the Chesapeake Bay and Patuxent River come alive in the only museum on the East Coast that is home to two lighthouses. See skates and rays, hand-crafted model boats, marine engines, wood carvings, aquariums, fossils and Chesapeake work boats. Outdoor exhibits include a boat basin, river otter habitat and a salt marsh. Wheelchair accessible.

## Solomons

Solomons is located at the southern tip of Calvert County. It is a lovely spot with a boardwalk right on the Patuxent River, water-view restaurants, marinas and shops. Annmarie Sculpture Garden & Arts Center can be found here as well as the Calvert Marine Museum and Drum Point Lighthouse, highlighting maritime history.



## Town of Chesapeake Beach 410-257-2230 (Town Hall)

The Town of Chesapeake Beach has a wonderful history as a waterfront resort town dating back to the 1900s. The town was built at the end of a rail line from Washington, D.C. and featured a 1,600-foot boardwalk with amusements built out over the Chesapeake Bay. Sadly, none of those features are still around, but thanks to local preservationists, the Chesapeake Beach Railway Museum tells the story of this historic location. Fun features of the town currently include the Chesapeake Beach Water Park, Rail Trail Boardwalk and nature boardwalk.

## Town of North Beach 301-855-6681 (Town Hall)

In the Town of North Beach, you'll find great restaurants, a fine arts gallery, novelty shops, gift shops, ice cream and a food market, all within walking distance of a pier, boardwalk and beach overlooking the Chesapeake Bay. If you need a peaceful break, stop by Wetlands Overlook Park or Mark P. Frazer Sunrise Garden and visit the Bayside History Museum.
